Entonces, podría calificar para la licencia de conducir comercial de Colorado (CDL, por sus siglas en inglés) sin tener que tomar el examen de manejo comercial. (Todavía se requiere los exámenes escritos. Todas las licencias CDL generalmente requieren al menos dos pruebas).

- No pague \$150-\$250 por el alquiler del vehículo para el examen
- No tiene que sacar permiso de aprendizaje de conducir

PROCESO:

- (1) Complete, firme y feche la primera página de la solicitud de Exención de prueba de habilidades de CDL militar.
- (2) Pídale a su oficial al mando que complete, firme y feche la página dos.
- (3) Complete, firme, y feche la Certificación de Licencia de 10 años de la Unidad CDL de la Division de Vehículos Motorizados de Colorado.
- (4) Mande una copia de su licencia militar o registro de manejo militar como prueba adicional de calificación
- (5) Envíe los formularios completados a la Unidad del DMV de Colorado

- (6) Si aún no lo ha hecho, haga una cita para un examen médico del Departamento de Transporte a través de un médico o centro de atención médica registrado en la FMCSA y obtenga su tarjeta médica del Departamento de Transporte. www.fmcsa.dot.gov/national-registry-certified-medical-examiners-search (información solo en inglés)
- (7) Obtenga una copia del Manual CDL actual en línea en DMV.Colorado.gov/im-commercial-driver (para ver la información en español, por favor utilice el traductor automático al pie de la página web) y estudie para el examen de Conocimientos generales y cualquier otro endoso como Frenos de Aire o Combinación para prepararse para las pruebas escritas requeridas.
- (8) Una vez que haya calificado para la exención, puede programar una cita en cualquier oficina de licencias de conducir de servicio completo, tomar y aprobar las pruebas escritas correspondientes, proporcionar su tarjeta médica del Departamento de Transporte (DOT, por sus siglas en inglés) y comprar su CDL con privilegios completos. (Aún se aplican las reglas para la prueba de identidad, nombre, edad y presencia legal y dirección residencial). Las citas se pueden hacer en myDMV.Colorado.gov.

You will still be required to pass any CDL knowledge (written) tests. This waiver is available only for the equivalent class of vehicle and only if you either are currently active military or were active within one year of this date.




