 All documents must be <u>unaltered certified originals, certified amended originals, or true copies certified by the issuing</u> <u>agency</u>. Photocopies, notarized documents, and online printouts are not accepted. If you are transferring driving privilege, you must also provide your driver license (valid or expired less than one year) or a motor vehicle report from your previous state/U.S. territory (dated within 30 days and showing a license that is valid or expired less than one year). Undocumented residents MUST make an appointment. Call 303-205-2335 or go to <i>myDMV.colorado.gov</i> to schedule an appointment. Undocumented residents will receive a document bearing the phrase: "Not valid for federal identification, voting, or public benefit purposes."
